Dear Residents, Patients, Families, Friends, and Staff:

Once again, I hope that this letter finds you all well. I am writing to provide another update on our efforts related to COVID-19 and our current status.

As you know we tested 152 staff members on April 30, 2020, in an effort to identify any possible carriers of COVID-19 that are asymptomatic. Today, May 7, 2020, we were notified that we had 1 staff member test asymptomatic positive, meaning this staff member had no symptoms at the time of testing. That staff member was notified to remain out of work until obtaining 2 negative test results.

We continue our very strict screening process for our staff entering the building. We also continue to screen staff 3 times per shift to ensure that any development of symptoms during their shift would be caught early. We also continue with very rigorous cleaning frequently throughout the day. In addition, any resident or patient returning from the hospital, or any new admission, must have a negative test preceding discharge from the hospital. New admissions and returning residents or patients must remain in isolation for 14 days upon return to further ensure they do not introduce the COVID-19 to the facility.

Our team is committed to keeping our residents, patients, and staff safe and healthy. We are also committed to keeping you informed of our COVID-19 status on our website located at <http://solarishealthcare.org/locations/osceola/>. We will continue to update this information daily for you.
