Dear Residents, Family, and Friends:

We hope this letter finds you all well. Unfortunately, due a to new, positive resident case on 9/13/2020, we are unable to open for Scheduled General Visitation on 9/15/2020, as tentatively planned. Per the Governor's directive we must be 14 days COVID free from the most recent positive result, whether it is a resident or staff member. We will notify you as soon as we are 14 days COVID free.

Essential Care Visitation that has been scheduled for the week will still occur as scheduled, as this particular visitor is exempt from the 14 day requirement. Please be aware that full Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is necessary for Essential visits. Minimally, a surgical mask is required. Cloth face coverings are not sufficient. Please keep in mind that only two (2) visitors are permitted with this designation, and only one (1) may come for a scheduled visit at a time.

We apologize for the inconvenience in regards to General Visitation, however, it is for the safety of our residents, their visitors, and our staff that we abide by the directives provided by the Governor's most recent order.
