To Residents and Families:

I wanted to reassure you that Solaris HealthCare Imperial is committed to doing everything in our power to keep residents safe during a hurricane or any unexpected event. We are monitoring Hurricane Elsa and the potential impacts to Southwest Florida. While it is still early to determine the exact impact to Naples, the system will be near the state early next week.

We remain in contact with Collier County Department of Emergency Management to receive updates.

Solaris HealthCare Imperial utilizes a 350-KW generator to supply emergency power to the skilled nursing unit for lighting and air conditioning. This allows the center to avoid re-locating our residents to other areas in the building for air conditioning. This generator along with our existing 35KW generator will provide emergency power to our critical, life safety, and equipment branches. Solaris has contracts with 2 companies for transportation services to sister facilities outside the county if the need arises.
