To All,

This update letter is to inform you that our center has been experiencing a surge in COVID positive employees since 12/28/21. The facility began "outbreak testing" of all residents, and staff team members, regardless of vaccination status, on that same date. To date, three (3) residents have tested positive for COVID-19 and remain on transmission-based precautions in a specifically Covid-19 designated area of the center. Of special note, the majority of COVID positive employees are fully vaccinated and many had received a booster dose.

The center will continue its COVID-19 "outbreak testing" of residents and employees, regardless of vaccination status, every 5-7 days per CDC and CMS recommendations until the center meets criteria to discontinue testing (14-days with no additional positive test results). We are in frequent contact with the local Department of Health and their representative confirms as Martin County is experiencing this same surge.

We ask that all indoor visitors wear a mask throughout the center, including resident rooms, regardless of your or your loved one's vaccination status. Please continue to practice social distancing from staff, other residents, and visitors, and perform frequent hand hygiene.
