Dear Residents, Family & Friends:

Welcome to Solaris Healthcare Coconut Creek!

Visitation can be conducted through different means, based on a facility's structure and residents' need. Outdoor visitation is preferred, even when the resident and visitor are fully vaccinated against COVID19, it generally poses a lower risk of transmission due to increased space and airflow. Indoor visitation can occur in a resident's room or designated visitation area. Visits for residents in a shared room should not be conducted, if possible. During indoor visitation, visitor movement should be limited e.g., visitors should not walk around different halls of the facility, interact with other residents, or interact with staff without maintaining social distancing guidelines.
